

STEPS FOR PATENT FILING IN INDIA

Who can file: Only a defined applicant (Inventor or Authorised person).

Where to file: At the Indian Patent Office with required forms and fees.

Mandatory forms to start:

- Form-1: Application for grant of patent (applicant, inventor, title, signature).
- Form-2: Specification (provisional or complete, description, claims, abstract).

Other forms (can be submitted later)

- Form-3: Statement & Understanding (foreign filings).
- Form-5: Declaration of inventorship.
- Form-26: Authorization for Patent Agent/Attorney.

TIPS: Filing date is given only after Form-1, Form-2 & formal fees submission.

Additional Patent Filing Requirements

- Priority Document: Required if based on an overseas filing (Paris Convention/ PCT).
- Verification Translation: Mandatory if the earlier application is not in English/ Hindi.
- Form-29: Filed by small entities/ start-ups to claim benefits.
- **Signing:** All paperwork, forms & drawings must be signed by the authorized person.
